PATIENT INFORMATION FOR DATA PROTECTION

Dear Patient,

The protection of your personal data is important to us. According to the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), we are obliged to inform you about the purpose for which our outpatient clinic collects, stores, and forwards data. Your rights regarding data protection are also provided in part 6 of this information page.

1.RESPONSIBILITY FOR DATA PROCESSING

2. WHICH DATA WILL BE PROCESSED

We, the Allergy Outpatient Clinic, process personal data that we receive from you as part of the business relationship. These include insurance data *, health data ** and personal data (if relevant for the medical history and the diagnostic procedure based thereon) ***.

* master data, which are necessary for the calculation of the rendered services

** findings brought to us (for example, laboratory findings, pulmonary function tests, etc.), for which purposes other physicians who are treating you may also provide us with data (for example, in medical reports).

*** occupation, hobbies, animal husbandry, living situation, eating habits, place of birth

3. PURPOSE OF DATA PROCESSING

The collection of health data is a prerequisite for your treatment. If the necessary information is not provided, the administration of a precise or tailored treatment will not be possible. We process your personal data only in strict compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation. Prerequisites for this are:

- your consent, given for one or more purposes (Article 6 (1) lit. a, EU GDPR)

- the fulfillment of contractual obligations (Article 6 (1) lit. b, EU GDPR)

- the fulfillment of legal obligations (Article 6 (1) lit. c, EU GDPR)

- if other conditions according to Article 6 EU GDPR are fulfilled or must be observed by us.

4. RECIPIENT OF YOUR DATA

We only transfer your personal data to third parties if this is permitted by law or if you have consented. The recipients of your personal data could especially be other doctors (in particular your referring GP or medical specialist), hospitals, health insurance, or supplementary health insurance. In individual cases, the transmission of data to other authorized recipients may take place.

5. STORING YOUR DATA

Due to legal requirements (Ärztegesetz § 51 Abs. 3/Austrian Physicians Act § 51(3)), we are obliged to keep these data for a minimum of 10 years after completion of the treatment. We will then retain your information no longer than is necessary to fulfill our contractual or legal obligations or to assert, exercise, or defend against legal claims.

6. YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to receive information concerning the personal data relating to you. You may also request the correction of incorrect data. In addition, under certain conditions, you reserve the right to delete data, the right to restrict data processing, and the right to data portability. The processing of your data is based on legal regulations. Your consent is only required in exceptional cases. In these cases, you have the right to revoke your consent for future processing. You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the relevant data protection supervisory authority if you believe that the processing of your personal data is unlawful.
